Category poems. A collection of poems belonging to the same family, type. As we have analyzed above, while the book contains poems belonging to four families, all of them are unique and written very simply. The following is a description of a child who was simply a toy in the "Insects" series:

As IbnSina points out, it is simply stated that honey cures a thousand ailments, and that the venom of bees, which sting and give life, is also beneficial to man.

Epigraphic poems. The epigraph was first used to write on tombstones in ancient Greece. Epigraphs have been used in world literature since the 15th century. Epigraphs are also common in 19th century romantic works. J.Russo, A. Stendhal, I. Goethe, F. Schiller, A. Pushkin are also found in the works of Uzbek writers G. Gulom, A. Qahhor, O. Mukhtor and others. An epigraph is a small section that briefly reveals the essence of the main text. Without the epigraph of some works it is much more difficult to understand the essence of those works.

AkhunjonSafarov, which reflects the sincere love for the beloved people, grandparents, who surround the child's inner world, calling the child "granddaughter" and caressing him the most. It is made up of words that are easy for the bird to understand. These poems, which evoke the spirit of masculinity and bring to mind their grandparents, will inevitably attract the attention of the reader.

Every word in the poem is a fertilizer for our lives. It is described with a strange rhythm that the granddaughter wants to be a support to the grandfather for a lifetime, or to support him, because he sees and bequeaths his honor to the grand children.
