After gaining independence, our country has done a lot to educate young people in the spirit of patriotism, national pride and respect for national traditions and values, to educate a spiritually mature and physically healthy generation. To study topical issues related to the problems of youth, especially to create the necessary conditions for unorganized youth to find their place in life, to guide them to a profession, to encourage the proposals and initiatives of youth, to support them in every possible way. the realization of the talents and gifts of young people living in remote areas, their protection from various vices and alien ideas has become an important issue today. Therefore, it was necessary to radically improve activities in this area, create a solid legal basis for educating independently thinking, comprehensively developed and enterprising, courageous youth in accordance with the requirements of the time, and realize their intellectual and creative potential.

In view of the foregoing, in accordance with the decision of the IV Congress of the Youth Public Movement of Uzbekistan "Kamolot" dated June 30, 2017, in order to take into account suggestions and comments, the general public. The youth public movement "Kamolot" was founded in 2001. "Today, the movement is taking on very little responsibility, and we will fix that. The main goal is not to criticize, but to identify and solve problems in a timely manner," said President Shavkat Mirziyoyev[1]. This date, the founding day of the organization, June 30, has been declared "Youth Day" in our country. In addition, proposals were made to establish a number of state awards and titles for young people who have contributed to the development of various spheres of life in our country, to create a "Temurbek School" for teenagers. Kakhramon Kuronbaev was elected chairman of the Central Council of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan.

ANALYSIS AND METHODOLOGY OF THE LITERATURE

Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev dated July 5, 2017 No. PF-5106 "On improving the efficiency of the state youth policy and supporting the activities of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan", as well as the "Resolution of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan". No.

PQ-3138 dated July 18, 2017 "On comprehensive measures to improve the activities of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Uzbekistan". In addition, the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On State Youth Policy", the Law "On Celebrating the Day of Youth of the Republic of Uzbekistan" and other regulatory legal acts were developed.

The Youth Union of Uzbekistan is a non-governmental non-profit organization created to form an independently thinking young generation, protect youth from external threats and the harmful effects of "folk culture", provide comprehensive assistance and create conditions for the protection of youth. interests. Legal entities and individuals may join the Union in the manner prescribed by the Charter. In other words, citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan who have reached the age of 14 and under 30 years of age, and stateless persons permanently residing in the Republic of Uzbekistan who wish to support the goals of the Union can become members of the Union. [2] Members of the Union can also become non-governmental non-profit organizations and youth enterprises, institutions and organizations, as well as other legal entities whose constituent documents do not contradict the goals, objectives and program documents of the Union.

The main goal of the Union is to ensure the active participation of young people in the process of democratic, political and economic reforms, the strengthening of peace and harmony in society, the involvement of our country in the process of joining the ranks of developed countries and the effective protection of the rights, freedoms and legitimate interests of the younger generation, to improve the spiritual and professional level of boys and girls, to help them realize their intellectual and creative abilities.

The main tasks of the Youth Union are:

- ➤ the formation of young people who think independently, have their own position and beliefs, able to take a worthy place in society, be a decisive force and support in the process of reforming the country, its political culture, legal literacy and education of legal awareness;
- ➤ education of unorganized youth in the spirit of morality and military patriotism, instilling in them a sense of national pride and identity, involvement in ongoing events, respect for national and universal values;
- > protecting the rights and interests of young people, supporting their desire to acquire modern professions and engage in entrepreneurial activities;
- > support talented young people, create conditions for them to realize their creative and intellectual potential and involve them in scientific activities;
- ➤ formation of a healthy lifestyle, ecological culture among young people, especially unorganized youth, their wide involvement in systematic physical education and sports;
- ➤ Protecting young people from the influence of religious extremist organizations and other destructive ideas, from negative influence and threats coming from abroad under the guise of "mass culture", promoting the prevention of delinquency and crime among young people, etc.

RESULTS

As for the organizational structure of the Union, the management bodies of the Union include:

- ✓ Congress
- ✓ Central Council
- ✓ Executive Committee of the Central Council
- ✓ Central Control and Auditing Commission.

The structure of the organization is as follows:

- > Central Office of the Union;
- > territorial structures of the Union;
- > local structures of the Union;
- Primary organizations of the Union;
- Enterprises, organizations and institutions, including the media, wholly or under the auspices of the Union.

In order to encourage youth, the Union established several awards, including the Prize of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan for the most active youth of the year and the Sign of Uzbekistan for active youth in the country's socio-political life. The Youth Union Scholarship was established for students who excelled academically and were active, covering 35% of tuition fees. There is also a grant competition "Innovative Projects of Young Scientists of the Republic" for those wishing to implement innovative and creative ideas. The Youth - Our Future Foundation was established under the Union to support youth business initiatives, ideas and projects, to train unemployed youth in specialties and business skills. Commercial banks will provide preferential loans at a rate of 7% for young people to implement their business projects. [3] In addition, at the initiative of the President to popularize reading among the population, one of the most sensational projects was the traditional holding of the republican contest "Young Reader". The gift of the President to the winners of the republican competition - the car Spark - motivates many young people. The procedure for providing the "House of Youth" to young families on the basis of a long-term soft loan, subject to an initial contribution. In order to ensure youth employment in the regions, "Youth Labor Guzars" were created, consisting of various production and service points. "Sacred Youth" units were formed, which went from house to house to study the problems and interests of youth, diagnose the area, solve youth problems based on the findings.

DISCUSSION

Applicants to the university will also be considered by the Union. The recommendations issued by the Republican Commission of the organization provide for the admission of holders to study on the basis of the state budget without entrance exams in pedagogical areas. In addition to the above, the Digital Generation project has been launched to attract young people to the field of information technology (IT) and create new jobs in Uzbekistan through intellectual potential. The project provides training for young professionals in modern areas such as media, digital marketing, robotics, web programming, and eSports. On the eve of Youth Day, the Governors and Youth project was launched in the regions, which allows young people to communicate with akims of districts and cities on their problems and proposals. The World Youth Association of Uzbekistan has also been established to establish regular contacts and cooperation with Uzbek youth working and studying in different parts of the world. Over the past years, the Youth Union has become a pillar of youth, serving to increase the effectiveness of the state youth policy. An important factor in this is the adoption of regulations in this area. About 28 thousand new jobs have been created by the Youth - Our Future Foundation for youth business projects. Our youth, deeply aware of the essence of the 5 important initiatives put forward by our President, actively participates in its implementation.

In general, the State Prize "Mard oglon" and the medal "Kelajak Bunyodkori" were established to support young people, encourage them to work effectively in various fields, achieve high results and set an example for their peers. The fact that in recent years the President has entrusted
