His love in him awakened to art, he created various works, poems such as: Angel poem, Adele poem, Angelo poem, Liberty ode, Count Nulin poem, The Undertaker "Belkin's Tale", Demon poem, Dubrovsky novel, Captain's Daughter historical novel, Stone Guest play, Bronze Horseman poem, Mozart and Salieri play and others.

It is these works of high school students that educate well and make their views the most intense and vivid. With the same, they try to reveal these works more deeply and I read them with interest and discussing these works with everyone, they fully reveal what and how it was and why.

Not only the works but also the words of Pushkin open people's eyes that not all people are the same, and good. Because Vorontsov saw in me a collegiate secretary, and I confess that I think about myself that I am not like that. <...> and he said the same thing at the end of his word: I am moving away from all evil and will begin to create all good: first of all, I will quit the service and take up rhyme.

I want to finish with the word of Alexander Sergeevich Pushkin: People say that misfortune is a good school: maybe. But Happiness is the best university. He wanted to say with this that learning for every person should be in the first place and everyone should take education and of course be literate.

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
