Problem statement: In 2017, as a result of the organization of growing lemons in greenhouses built by the residents, raising chickens from 100 heads, an additional 1.2 thousand hectares of lemon groves were established, 3.2 million were distributed to 32 thousand households. 90-day-old chickens were distributed and 2.3 mln. egg production was achieved. Planting of fruit trees useful for human health, such as walnuts and unabi, was also organized. The most important thing is the carelessness of citizens in using the land assigned to them as an additional source of income, the incomplete formation of the culture of land use, and the fact that the mechanism of responsibility for the cases of land use without owners is not strictly defined in the laws related to the field. 18 hectares of farm land plot, Cases of inefficient use of 9,000 hectares have been identified. As a result of studies conducted in 2018, 4,000 hectares were acquired by the owners of 69,400 homesteads across the republic, including 995 hectares in Samarkand region, 649 hectares in Surkhandarya region, 624 hectares in Kashkadarya region, 384 hectares in Navoi region, Andijan 294 hectares in the region, 215 hectares in the Khorezm region and 323 hectares in the Republic of Karakalpakstan were not planted with agricultural crops.

The reforms carried out in the agrarian sector of our republic and their implementation, in particular, special attention to the principles of effective use of land resources, are giving positive results. In this regard, effective use of existing irrigated and dry land, preservation, restoration and increase of their soil fertility, their protection and purposeful use is considered one of the urgent tasks of today. The reforms carried out consistently by our government in agriculture, new forms of management - the creation of a management system for farmers and peasant farms, and the work being done to liberalize their activities are directly aimed at the development of the agricultural sector. Due to the changes in the forms of land ownership, the attention to the irrigated lands, which are the real national wealth of our people, the priceless property, the source of our sustenance, is increasing, and thus material benefits are being achieved.

Research Method. Agrarian reform is being carried out with a specific goal in mind. As a result, agriculture changed radically in the following years. Farms, by their nature, have become the main form of agricultural production, a leading force that ensures sustainable and efficient development of the sector. Most importantly, a real owner - a landowner - appeared in the village. In recent years, the effective use of land plots of farms, consistent and targeted, has become an important factor in increasing the efficiency of farmers' activities. The analysis showed that the formation of sustainable farms, a significant increase in their personal working capital, and the rational use of land and water resources, as well as mineral fertilizers, agricultural machinery and other resources, as well as the possibility of more precise organization of labor was created, and the material and technical base of farms was strengthened.

By implementing additional measures regarding the use of land plots owned by farms, to further increase the efficiency of their activities, to impartially and transparently select farmers as the rightful owners of the land, on this basis, to use land and other resources wisely, to increase productivity in the future. production, economic and financial indicators of farms operating in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and regions in order to increase and increase the volume of production of agricultural products, to improve the financial situation of farms and the growth of incomes of rural residents work is carried out with local working groups on in-depth analysis and bringing their land areas to the optimal size, optimization of the size of the plots of land owned by farms has been completed

As of January 1, 2020, the total land area within the administrative borders of the Republic of Uzbekistan is 44,892.4 thousand hectares, and irrigated land is 4,329 thousand hectares or 9.6% of the total land area. On October 9, 2017, adopted by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Mirziyoyev Shavkat Miromonovich, "Measures to protect the rights and legal interests of farmers, peasant farms and landowners, and to fundamentally improve the system of effective use of

agricultural arable land" It is no exaggeration to say that the Decree No. PF-5199 "on" has opened the door of great opportunities for the further development of the agricultural system. In this Decree, the farmer, priority tasks aimed at protecting the rights and legal interests of farmers and homestead land owners and increasing the efficiency of their land use were defined. In addition, further development of the activities of farms and landowners, creation of an effective system for the protection of their rights and legal interests, and improvement of the normative legal framework in this area were specially addressed. In addition, this decree also spoke about the establishment of multi-sector farms, the fundamental improvement of their activities, and the efficient use of land in multi-sector farms. That is:

As of January 1, 2021, the number of agricultural enterprises and organizations in the republic, together with farms, is 112,855, and the total land area of the land assigned to them is 24,057.1 thousand hectares, including agricultural the area of land types is 19450.6 thousand hectares, of which 3693.8 thousand hectares are irrigated lands.of the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan 53.59 percent agricultural landand is the main tool in agricultural production. The distribution of land intended for agricultural purposes in the territory of the republic is determined according to natural climatic factors. According to the status of January 1, 2022, the total number of farms is 84,222, including: cotton-grain growing 25,597, grain growing 6,436, animal husbandry 10,133, horticulture 21,030, viticulture 4,864, vegetable growing policing was 4773, blacksmithing 743, and 10646 in other directions. As of January 1, 2020, the total land area allocated to them in our republic is 7331 thousand hectares, including 3271.9 thousand hectares of arable land, 273.5 thousand hectares of perennial trees, 31 thousand hectares of gray land, pastures and hayfields 3131,A farm is an independent economic entity with legal personality, based on the joint activity of members of the farm, which produces agricultural products using plots of land leased to it for a long period of time.
